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MINUTES OF THE FIRST MEETING OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL HELD ON
25TH MAY, 2011 AT 10:00HRS IN THE MAIN COMMITTEE ROOM
ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR

First meeting of Academic Council, Islamia College Peshawar was held on 25th May 2011 at 10:00hrs in the Main Committee Room, Islamia College Peshawar under the Chairmanship of Prof. Dr. Haider Shah, Vice-Chancellor.

Qari Abdur Rauf started proceedings of the meeting with recitation from the Holy Quran.

The Registrar welcomed the participants of the Academic Council which was being held for the first time since establishment of the University in 2008. He added that after assuming the charge as Registrar in June, 2010, on the specific instructions of the Vice-Chancellor, Mr. Ajmal Khan, Board of Studies and Board of Faculty were formed, so that the meeting of Academic Council, which is the highest academic body of University, could be convened, yet, due to abduction of the Vice-Chancellor, the matter received a set back. After appointment of the acting Vice-Chancellor Prof. Dr. Haider Shah, he also advised him to ensure holding of the meeting of the Academic Council as early as possible.

The Vice-Chancellor thanked the members of the Academic Council and said that it was a matter of honour for all of us to attend the maiden meeting of Academic Council Islamia College Peshawar and give consideration to the recommendations of Boards of Faculties regarding approval of courses being taught in the University. He added that the University is still in an initial stage and we have to do a lot to consolidate it to achieve high standard of academics and to keep pace with national and international Universities. He hoped that the University would benefit from the experience and knowledge of some veteran faculty members who had been members of such bodies in the University of Peshawar for a considerable period. He hoped that with the help and cooperation of the members of the Council, the agenda of the meeting will be disposed in a satisfactory manner with due regard to Rules of Business.

On the query of the Chairman, Department of Urdu the Registrar read Section 24(1) of Islamia College Peshawar Act- 2009 regarding composition of Academic Council Islamia College Peshawar and Section 4 (2) of the First Statutes of Islamia College Peshawar Act-2009 regarding appointment of Deans. The Registrar clarified that Prof. Dr. Nasib Dar

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does not fall in the Faculty of Languages and Literature. Besides, he had been appointed as Dean Faculty of Religious and Legal Studies by the Senate in its meeting held on 09.02.2010. Being only Professor available in the Faculty of Languages and Literature, name of Prof. Dr. Abdus Salam was recommended to the Provincial Higher Education Department for Deanship, Faculty of Languages and Literature, Islamia College Peshawar.

The Chairman, Department of Urdu further observed regarding appointment of Chairpersons in the University according to the provisions of the Act. The Registrar explained that the Vice-Chancellor had appointed some chairpersons, subject to final approval of the Syndicate as provided under Section- 5(2) of 1st Statutes of Islamia College Peshawar. Act- 2009 and their cases will be placed before the Syndicate in the next meeting for final approval. Then, formal agenda of the meeting was taken up for consideration as under:

Item No 1: PROPOSED DRAFT OF RULES OF BUSINESS OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The Academic Council considered the draft Rules of Business of Academic Council and recommended it for approval of the Syndicate.

Item No 2: REGULATIONS FOR SEMESTER SYSTEM, ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR

While considering the Item, Prof. Dr. Nisar Chairman, Department of Islamic Theology circulated a letter No.75/ dated/ 24.05.2011 wherein some amendments were proposed in the draft Regulations for Semester System which were discussed by the Council as under:

Definitions:

The clause was amended as under:

- 2(a) **Academic advisor:** A member of the Academic Staff to be appointed by the Chairperson in consultation with the Dean concerned for guiding and counseling and for supervising their academic performance till their final graduation from the University.

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2.hh. **Thesis Supervisor/Advisor:** While discussing the item, it was observed that this point has already been decided in the Deans' Committee and the decision should have been reflected in the suggested amendments. The amount of Rs. 2,880/- + Rs. 240 for viva exam has not been approved by any forum. Thus it was decided that thesis charges would be Rs. 1600/- + 10% increase which would be given to Internal and External supervisor equally. (However, it was observed that Rs.2,880/- were charged up till the present session).

2.hh. M.S/M.Phil students: Ph.D degreein his areas of study. Similarly MS **Electronics** may supervise the M.Sc students.

The Dean, Faculty of Languages & Literature was directed to go through the draft regulations and propose necessary changes, if needed. After consideration the Council amended the regulations as under:-

2. **Definitions:**

- d. 'Cease' is not a proper word and be replaced with 'Ceasing'.
- J. Audit course should be added

3. **Introduction**

- 3.1 The word 'Hons' should be omitted.
- 3.2 At the end of the para, "and LL.B Shariah (5-year)" be added.

The Chairman, Department of Urdu proposed that conventional 2-year course may be allowed for the Departments of Islamic Theology and Urdu. It was observed that this proposal was not put to the Committee at the time of preparation of the Semester Rules. The Vice-Chancellor remarked that two different systems can not operate in one University simultaneously. However, it was allowed for departments of Theology and Urdu till their students of B.S. reach to 5th Semester.

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4. Schemes of Studies:

Some members were of the view that admission should be made in specific subject from the day one because the students do not know as to which subject they would study, so separate 4-year programme may be introduced instead of Integrated Program. Admission should be based on subject specific before a student study for two semesters, instead of admitting the students in combination of subjects. It was decided that, in future, admissions would be subject specific/oriented. Further two schemes of studies can not be allowed in one University. However, minimum threshold for admission is to be fixed. Minimum number of students to be admitted in a subject was put to vote and by a majority vote it was decided that a subject would be offered to, at least, ten candidates seeking admission in a specific subject. Admission must be closed one week before starting of classes.

The Chairman, Department of Islamiyat requested that 2 credit hours course of Islamiyat must be converted into 3 credit hours. It was decided that 2 credit hours is HEC'S requirement, which can not be changed so Islamiyat and Pakistan Studies must also be offered as an optional subject. Regarding replacement of English-IV, it was decided that it should be retained and taught to the students. However, the matter can be reviewed at the Board of Studies of the department concerned.

4.1 Four-year Bachelor Degree:

The Council discussed the present 4-year Integrated Program of the University in detail.

The Director APARO explained that 4-year integrated program is being taught in all leading Universities and the courses were designed after visiting renowned Universities in the country according to the criteria of the HEC. The Dean Faculty of Biological Sciences was of the view that from the very beginning, the students should know about their subject and in this regard the University should not impose its will on the students and subject choice should be given to the students.

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Majority of the members of the Council voted for continuation of 4-year Integrated program in the University.

4.1.f. It is not in accord with the clause 7.30.

4.2 **Two-Year Master Degree**

Another clause 4.4 for M. Phil and Ph. D courses should be added.

5. **Courses of Study**

The Chairman Department of Pashto proposed that along with 4-year programme, B.A, B.Sc scheme of studies should also be restarted. Chairman Department of Theology maintained that conventional system for M.A courses should be restored. It was decided that operation of two systems at degree level are not possible.

6. **Teaching Methodology:**

6.3 While reviewing the clause, it was amended as under:

“Teaching in various courses shall be conducted in the University departments/ constituent/affiliated institutions, in any appropriate method as per requirements of the respective course. Teaching methods may include lectures, tutorials, discussions, seminars, demonstrations, practical work in laboratories, field work and any other methods of instructions approved by the Academic Council”

7. **Admissions:**

While discussing the point, the Dean, Faculty of Languages & Literature was of the view that BS 4-year degree is equal to MA/M.Sc. Yet, the role of the teaching departments has been reduced to zero. He proposed that separate subject system should be adopted. Chairman Department of Statistics said that mode of admission should be determined. At present

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admission is given to the students in three subjects because they do not know about the specific subject, so admission should be based on subject specific.

Majority of the members of the Council supported that admission should be department-based and subject choice should be given to the students.

The Council decided that for BS 4-year programme, subject-specific admission would be made from the next session.

7.3 Three options will be given to the candidates in the Admission Form.

7.14 The Council decided that both the Students will be admitted

7.30. **Ineligibility:** - The clause was amended as under:-

The following shall not be eligible for admission to Masters and Bachelors programmes:-

- a) Those who have ceased to be students of the University.
- b) Those already on the rolls of the University or any other University except those already possessing an equivalent degree from this or any other University.

7.31 **Age Limit:**

If a candidate is overage, yet he has secured higher marks or equal marks to the last admitted candidate, may be given age relaxation on case to case basis.

7.32. The Discipline Committee may cancel/refuse admission of any student without assigning any reason.

8. **Semesters:**

8.1.c : In line 5 the Word 'neglectful' be replaced with 'negligent'

In line 7 the word 'reconcile' be replaced with 'abide by'

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14.08 After consideration, the Council amended the clause as under:

Leave upto 05 days shall be sanctioned by the Chairman of the Department concerned. Sanction of leave beyond one week will be granted by Dean on the recommendation of chairperson concerned. The maximum leave period to be availed in exceptional cases on very genuine grounds in one semester will not exceed twelve (12) working days.

17. **Grading Policy:**

17.2 A Committee has already been appointed to look into the matter.

Appellate Committee:

57. The Council directed that it should be amended as follows:-

The Vice Chancellor may appoint an Appellate Committee to hear the appeals against the decisions of the Unfair Means Committee. The Committee shall comprise of two senior faculty members, not below the rank of Professor. The decision of the Appellate Committee shall be binding and final. However, for composition of the Appellate Committee the pattern of the University of Peshawar may be followed.

With the above proposed amendments, the Regulations for Semester System in Islamia College Peshawar were recommended for approval.

Item No. 3: ESTABLISHMENT OF QUALITY ENHANCEMENT CELL IN THE ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR

The Academic Council recommended the action taken by the competent authority Islamia College Peshawar regarding establishment of Quality Enhancement Cell and appointment of Dr. Sareer Badshah, Chairman, Department of Statistics as Director Quality Enhancement Cell in Islamia College Peshawar, Vide Notification No. 525/Regr dated/02.02.2011.

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Item No. 4: CONSIDERATION ON THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BOARD OF FACULTY OF BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

The Academic Council considered the Minutes of the meeting of Board of Faculty of Biological Sciences dated/ 25/10/2010 and recommended them for approval as provided under Section 25(2)(h) of the Islamia College Peshawar Act-2009.

Item No. 5: CONSIDERATION ON THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BOARD OF FACULTY OF LANGUAGES AND LITERATURE

The Academic Council considered the Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Faculty of Languages and Literature held on 14/04/2011 and recommended them for approval as provided under Section 25(2)(h) of the Islamia College Peshawar Act-2009, except 3rd part of Paper 10 in the proposed MA Urdu Syllabus. It was also suggested that credit hours must be incorporated in the subject of English.

Item No. 6: CONSIDERATION ON THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BOARD OF FACULTY OF RELIGIOUS & LEGAL STUDIES

The Academic Council considered the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Faculty of Religious and Legal Studies held on 19/07/2010 and 17/08/2010 and recommended them for approval as provided under Section 25(2)-(h) of the Islamia College Peshawar Act -2009.

Item No. 7: RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR CHITRALI STUDENTS UNDER THE DIRECTIVES OF GOVERNOR KHYBER-PAKHTUNKHWA, PAKISTAN

The Registrar read out the contents of letter No. SO(HE-I) 6(11)8/GS/10/870/UE dated 24/03/2011, Department of Higher Education wherein a request for reservation of seats for Chitrali Students in Islamia College Peshawar was made. The Council considered the proposal and did not agree to it.

Item No. 8: RESERVING 2% SEATS ON SPORTS BASIS UNDER THE DIRECTIVES OF HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION ISLAMABAD

The Council was informed that the Adviser (HRD) HEC in a letter No. Sports-I/HEC /2010/735 dated 21/07/2010 made a request that 2% of the seats be reserved for sports based admissions at undergraduate level with immediate effect. The Vice-Chancellor said

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that five percent seats had already been reserved for the Sportsmen in the Inter Prospectus. In view of this fact, the Council did not agree to reserve additional 2% seats for the sportsmen in the University and directed that the Advisor (HRD) HEC be informed of the state of affairs accordingly.

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Item No.3: ATTENDANCE AND REGISTRATION OF STUDENTS/TEACHERS

Dr. Sareer Badshah, Chairman, Department of Statistics and Director Quality Enhancement Cell explained the proposal before the Academic Council. He said that as per practice in force, attendance of the students is sent to APARO. He proposed that the students' attendance should be sent to Internal Controller of Exams. The Internal Controller of Exams will notify attendance position after 04 months, copy of which would be endorsed to APARO for record.

Regarding workload of the teachers he added that he had designed a proforma, which was shown to the members of the Council. He added that the workload proforma would be provided to all teaching departments which would be filled in by all the teaching staff itself on monthly basis. Regarding payment of extra workload he explained that Internal Controller of Exams would initiate the proforma for extra workload carried out by the teaching staff. The prescribed workload should not be more than 06 credit hours. The Chairman, Department of Archeology pointed out that, at present, the formula of the University of Peshawar about the teaching workload is being followed in the University.

The Vice-Chancellor urged that keeping in view the weak financial position of the University, the teaching staff should sacrifice one Cr hr for the sake of the University.

The Council further agreed that attendance of the students should be sent on fortnightly basis to APARO i.e. on 1st and 16th of every month. It was further decided that for the sake of transparency, workload proforma should be audited by an Internal Auditor before payment is released. It was further decided that in view of heavy responsibilities of the Internal Controller of Exams, he is given concession of one Cr hr in his workload. The Council appointed Prof. Dr. Syed Zahir Shah, Dean, Faculty of Biological Sciences as Internal Auditor.

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Item No.4: RESERVATION OF SEATS FOR SENIOR ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

The Vice-Chancellor informed the Academic Council that at present one seat is reserved for the children of registered members of Senior Alumni Association Islamia College Peshawar. Yet, the Association has requested for reservation of 03 seats-02 seats in Boys section and 01 seat in Girls section. The Council agreed to allocate one more seat in Boys section for the children of registered members of Senior the Alumni Association, Islamia College Peshawar.

Item No.5: CONSIDERATION ON THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF BOARD OF FACULTY OF NATURAL SCIENCES, ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR
