

Minutes of the 47th meeting of the Academic Council held on 24-06-2013

The 47th meeting of the Academic Council of the Islamia College Peshawar was convened on 24-06-2013 in the main Committee Room. It started with Tilawat-e-Quran. The Vice Chancellor Dr. Ihsan Ali chaired the meeting. List is attached of the other members who attended the meeting.

Agenda of the Meeting: Restructuring of Faculties

The Vice Chancellor Professor Dr. Ihsan Ali welcomed all participants. He pointed out that allocation of departments to the faculties should take place in line with the HEC defined nomenclature. The Vice Chancellor said that as per existing criteria of HEC, a teaching department should have 1 Professor, 1 Associate Professor, 2 Assistant Professors and 4 Lecturers. He stressed for Restructuring of Faculties in accordance with Section 25 (2) (c) of the ICP Act 2012.-

After discussion and consideration on the subject, Professor Dr. Jauhar Ali questioned the allocation of Islamic Theology in the Faculty of Arts & Languages and suggested that the same be placed under the umbrella of Faculty of Social Sciences. Professor Dr. Abdus Salam Khalis, Professor Dr. Naeem Khalid and all other members endorsed the suggestion.

Decision: The participants endorsed the recommendations of the Restructuring Committee and reduced the number of faculties to 4 except one change that the Department of Islamic Theology be made part of the Faculty of Social Sciences.

Therefore, the following faculties were approved:

- a. **Faculty of Life Sciences:** Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Chemistry.
- b. **Faculty of Physical & Numerical Sciences:** Physics, Statistics, Maths, Computer Science, Telecommunication, and Electronics.
- c. **Faulty of Social Sciences:** Economics, Political Science, Psychology, Law, Sharia, Management Studies, Islamic Theology and Pakistan Studies.
- d. **Faculty of Arts and Languages:** English, Urdu, Pashto, and Arabic.

The meeting ended with a note of mutual cooperation and reciprocal vote of thanks.
