

MINUTES OF 8th MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR HELD ON 28th MAY, 2018 AT 10:00 AM IN THE MAIN COMMITTEE ROOM, ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR

The 8th Meeting of the Academic Council, Islamia College Peshawar was held on 28th May, 2018 at 10.00 am in the Main Committee Room, Islamia College Peshawar which was presided over by the worthy Vice-Chancellor, Islamia College Peshawar, Prof. Dr. Habib Ahmad (TI). List of participants is attached herewith.

Proceeding of the meeting was started with recitation of few verses from the Holy Quran. The Vice-Chancellor warmly welcomed & thanked all the members of the Council for sparing their precious time to attend the meeting in the Holy month of Ramadan. The Vice-Chancellor in his opening remarks stated that Islamia College Peshawar is decidedly the most first-choice College in the Province. ITEM#6(i): CONSIDERATION OF THE DECISIONS TAKEN IN THE MEETING OF FEDERAL CABINET HELD ON 2nd MARCH, 2017.

Summary:

The decision of the Federal Cabinet regarding Quota of FATA students was communicated by Mr. Awais Ahmad, Director General, Higher Education Commission, Islamabad discussed in details. The Registrar sought the Chair's attention and brought into the notice of the Council about the recent decision of merger of FATA in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. He further stated that since the decision of the Cabinet held on 2nd March 2017 states that "*quota of FATA students in education, health institutions in other Provinces should be doubled and retained for 10 years after integration with Khyber Pakhtunkhwa*" is ambiguous, therefore, opinion may be sought in the first place from the relevant Departments.

Decision:

The House unanimously decided that in the first instance a letter may be sent by the office of the Registrar to the quarters concerned to seek opinion and guidance in the matter.

ITEM#6(ii): CONSIDERATION OF THE HEC's POLICY REGARDING "CGPA" EQUIVALENCE OF GRADES

Summary:

Prof. Dr. Abdus Salam, Chairman, Department of English and Convener of the Academic Standing Committee apprised the House that the above quoted Committee has almost completed work on the subject policy, which shall be presented in the ensuing meeting of the Academic Council for its consideration.

Decision:

The Academic Council unanimously agreed to refer the subject Policy to the Academic Standing Committee for consideration and incorporation in the draft


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Policy, if deemed expedient. It was also decided that the draft Regulations in this connection would be placed before the Academic Council for consideration.

ITEM#6(iii): CONSIDERATION OF HEC'S POLICY REGARDING SUPERVISION OF MS/M.PHIL RESEARCH THESIS BY MS / M.PHIL QUALIFIED FACULTY MEMBERS

Decision:

The guidelines/policy regarding the supervision of MS/M.Phil Research Thesis by MS/M.Phil qualified faculty members was considered & referred to the Academic Standing Committee to look into the same and submit its recommendations to the Academic Council for consideration.

ITEM#6(iv): CONSIDERATION OF THE POLICY OF MINIMUM EXPERIENCE OF A PH.D FACULTY MEMBER TO SUPERVISE A PH.D THESIS

Summary:

The National Quality Assurance Committee (NQAC) in its 22nd meeting held on 09.01.2017 has approved the Policy of minimum experience of a Ph.D faculty member to supervise a Ph.D Thesis and provided through letter received from Ms. Sadia Bukhari, Assistant Director (QAD), Higher Education Commission, Islamabad.

The subject matter was discussed in the 3rd meeting of the Quality Enhancement Cell, Islamia College Peshawar which recommended as follows:

"Bar of 03 Years Post PhD experience may be reduced to 01 Post PhD experience for thesis supervision"

Both the letter of Higher Education Commission and Minutes of the 3rd Meeting of the Quality Enhancement Cell were placed before the Council for deliberation.

Decision:


The Policy of minimum experience of a PhD faculty member to supervise a PhD Thesis was considered & referred to the Syndicate for consideration.

ITEM#6(v): CONSIDERATION OF POLICY OF HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION REGARDING RESPONSIBILITY ON THE SUPERVISOR OF PLAGIARIZED PH.D/MS/MP THESIS

Summary:

The Policy of the Higher Education Commission regarding fixation of the responsibility on the supervisor of plagiarized PhD/MS/MP Thesis was discussed in detail.

The Council agreed with the decision of the National Quality Assurance Committee (NQAC) made in its 22nd meeting held on 09.01.2017 with regard to the responsibility on the supervisor of plagiarized Ph.D/ MS/MP Thesis and recommended the same policy to the Syndicate for adoption/insertion in the relevant Statutes/Regulations/Policy mutatis mutandis.

ITEM#6(vi): CONSIDERATION OF POLICY OF BLACK LISTING OF PLAGIARISM COMPLAINANT FOR FALSE ALLEGATION

Summary:

The Registrar, Islamia College Peshawar briefed the Council about the Policy of Black listing of Plagiarism Complainant for false allegations and stated that the National Quality Assurance Committee in its 22nd meeting held on 09.01.2017

upheld the decision of HEC Plagiarism Standing Committee meeting held on August 23, 2016 that the complainant of false allegation of plagiarism be black listed for five years.

Decision:

The Council agreed with the decision of the National Quality Assurance Committee (NQAC) made in its 22nd meeting held on 09.01.2017 with regard to the punishment of Plagiarism Complainant for false allegation and recommended to the Syndicate for adoption/insertion the same policy mutatis mutandis in the relevant Plagiarism Policy/Regulations/Statutes.



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ITEM #6(viii):

**LAUNCH OF TESTS BY THE EDUCATION TESTING COUNCIL FOR
ADMISSION TO UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS IN UNIVERSITIES
AND DEGREE AWARDING INSTITUTIONS**

Summary:

The Executive Director, Higher Education Commission, Prof. Dr. Arshad Ali thorough letter informed this University that the Commission has established "Education Testing Council (ETC)" w.e.f Jan 25, 2017, which provides the facility of free, uniform, standardized, and accessible assessment tests for admission to the Universities and Degree Awarding Institutions across Pakistan.

Higher Education Commission via above quoted letter has sought the support to CONFIRM adoption of ETC Aptitude test for admission to undergraduate programs from Fall 2017, in this University.

Decision:

The Council unanimously agreed to refer it to the Academic Standing Committee for consideration and to submit its report to the Academic Council in this regard.

ITEM # 6(ix):

**REQUEST OF THE CHAIRMAN HEC REGARDING ANNOUNCEMENT
OF MS/PH.D LEVEL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE STUDENTS OF
MUSLIM WORLD**

Summary:

The Chairman, Higher Education Commission, had made a request for announcement of MS/M.Phil and Ph.D level scholarships fully funded by the University (Tuition Fee + Hostel Charges + Monthly living allowance + any other expenses in lieu of Studies & Research) for Students of Muslim world clearly indicating number, discipline and program of scholarship.

The Vice-Chancellor apprised the House that Islamia College Peshawar has recently established an Endowment Fund to facilitate local and foreign scholars in short term/long term, diploma or degree programs. Scholarships may be offered to the foreign scholars of the Muslim World out of the Endowment Fund established recently for the purpose.



“There shall be one degree of five/05 years called LLB or LLB Shariah & Law. Provided that the existing BS Semester in Examination Rules/Regulations shall be mutatis mutandis apply to LLB or LLB Shariah & Law as the case may be and which is not otherwise specific for any discipline”.

ITEM#9(i): CONSIDERATION OF THE REQUESTS FOR REFUND OF EXAMINATIONS FEE

Summary:


The Secretary of the House drew the attention of the members and stated that certain students had filed applications to the office of the Controller of Examinations, Islamia College Peshawar for refund of examinations fee. However, the Controller of Examinations has raised the observations that as per Regulations of the Islamia College Peshawar approved by the Syndicate, the students have no right of refund of fee. Furthermore, Treasurer Office has also raised the observations on the refund of examinations fee and remarked that the rules do not permit the same. To avoid any legal complications, the Vice-Chancellor referred the subject matter to the Academic Council for deliberation.





Decision:



ITEM # 17: PHASING OUT TWO YEARS DEGREE PROGRAMMES BA/BSC & MA/MSC BY THE YEARS 2018 & 2020 RESPECTIVELY

Summary:

Higher Education Commission, in a circular sent to all universities across Pakistan said that no university will offer admission in conventional BA/BSc after Academic Year 2018 & in MA/MSc after Academic Year 2020. HEC said that a committee of experts from different universities, constituted by HEC, has devised a mechanism to accommodate existing BA/BSc students into 4-year BS programmes.

After analyzing BA/BSc programmes of different universities, the Committee proposed a bridging semester as a foundation for such students to enter fifth semester of a 4-year programme, after which they can complete remaining four semesters in years to attain BS degree.

Decision:

The Council considered & unanimously agreed that the decision of the Higher Education Commission regarding phasing out two years degree programs BA/BSc & MA/MSc may not be acceded to presently. However, the decision of phasing out of the aforesaid degree programs may be made by the statutory bodies of the University as per directives of the Government.

(8) یہ خط اگر واقعی اجازت نامہ تھا تو مئی 2012 سے لے کر مارچ 2017 تک پانچ کی مدت میں پاکستان سنڈیز ڈیپارٹمنٹ نے پی۔ایچ ڈی کے داخلے کیوں نہیں کرائے۔ جس کی آج چھ سال بعد 2018 میں اجازت لینے کی ضرورت پیش آرہی ہے۔ پانچ سال کی یہ خاموشی بھی اس بات کا ثبوت ہے کہ یہ خط کوئی اجازت نامہ نہیں بلکہ محض معلوماتی مراسلہ تھا۔ جس کے معیار پر یہ شعبہ آج بھی پورا نہیں اترتا محض کاغذات سے ایجنڈے کا پیٹ بھرنے سے شعبہ جات میں پی۔ایچ ڈی پروگرام چلانے کی اجازت نہیں دی جاسکتی۔ فیکلٹی مکمل کر کے اس کیس کو دوبارہ اکیڈمک کونسل سے منظوری کے لیے بھجوا دیا جائے۔ بصورت دیگر اس صریح غلطی کا ازالہ کرتے ہوئے اس پروگرام کو فی الفور منسوخ کیا جائے تاکہ ادارے کی ساکھ برقرار رہے۔
