Item No.10(i):**REGULATIONS FOR COMPOSITE BA/MA ANNUAL SYSTEM (PRIVATE) ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR**

The Regulations duly forwarded by the Controller of Examinations for governing & Regulating the affairs of one year composite BA and MA Program (Private) at Islamia College Peshawar were considered by the Council.

**DECISION:**

**a:** As provided under clause-a of sub-section-1 of section-29 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Universities Act, 2012 read with sub-section-2 of section-29 of the aforementioned Act, the Academic Council considered the *Regulations for one year composite BA/MA Program (Private), Islamia College Peshawar* and recommended to the Syndicate for approval.

Furthermore, the Academic Council also endorsed the anticipatory approval of the Vice-Chancellor, Islamia College Peshawar regarding launching of one year BA/MA composite Program, which will continue till as per the Government Policy.

**b:** The Dean Faculty of Religious & Legal Studies will come up a detail proposal for starting B. I Th to the ensuing meeting of the Council.

Item No 10(ii):

**CONSIDERATION OF AMENDMENTS IN THE ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR STUDENTS CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE REGULATIONS, 2009 (AMENDED 2019)**

The Council considered the proposed amendments in the Regulations namely; *"the Islamia College Peshawar Students Conduct & Discipline Regulations-2009"* which have been incorporated in the consolidated draft of the Regulations.

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**DECISION:**

As provided under sub-section-2 of section-29 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Universities Act, 2012, the proposed Regulations were recommended to the Syndicate for approval.

Item No 10(iii):

**CONSIDERATION OF AMENDMENTS IN THE ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR HIGHER STUDIES (M.PHIL/MS/PHD) REGULATIONS 2017**

**DECISION:**

The Academic Council considered the proposal of the Advanced Studies & Research Board and recommended with certain changes to the Syndicate the amendment of the following clause as mentioned below:

Section-23(i) of the Islamia College Peshawar Higher Studies (M.Phil/MS/PhD) Regulations 2017 states as follows;

*"In consultation with the Supervisor, the Head shall recommend to the Vice-Chancellor through the Dean of the Faculty, a panel of at least five experts from the technologically advanced countries and five from within the country. The Vice-Chancellor will appoint four examiners for the evaluation of Dissertation, two of whom shall be local (one will be evaluator as well as examiner for public defense whereas second one be for the public defense only) and two shall be foreign. Majority positive opinion shall count towards the award of the degree"*

Item No 10(iv):

**CONSIDERATION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ADVANCED STUDIES & RESEARCH BOARD REGARDING CLARIFICATION IN ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION IN MPhil/MS/PHD**

The Council considered the observations of the Advanced Studies Research Board raised in its 20<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2019 regarding eligibility criteria for admission in M.Phil/MS/PhD as mentioned below;

- i. *Consideration of BS-4 Years (less than 130 credit hours) cases of Management Sciences in MS Program.*

- ii. *Clarification whether 18 years of education for admission in PhD Program is with thesis or without thesis.*

**DECISION:**

The Council recommended the following to the Syndicate for approval:

- i. Higher Education Commission's criteria shall be followed.
- ii. 18 years education will be named as "M.Phil" only from now onwards in Islamia College Peshawar.
- iii. Admission in PhD will be granted to only those who have 18 years education (MS/MPhil) with thesis.

The recommendations of the Academic Standing Committee, Islamia College Peshawar made in its various meetings about the semester system at Islamia College Peshawar were considered by the Academic Council.


