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FINAL MINUTES OF 14th MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR HELD ON 1st JULY, 2021 AT 10:00 AM IN THE MAIN COMMITTEE ROOM, ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR

The 14th Meeting of the Academic Council, Islamia College Peshawar was held on 1st July, 2021 at 10.00 am in the Main Committee Room, Islamia College Peshawar which was presided over by the Worthy Vice-Chancellor, Islamia College Peshawar, Prof. Dr. Gul Majid Khan. (*List of participants is attached herewith*):

Proceedings of the meeting were started with recitation of few verses from the Holy Quran. The Vice-Chancellor warmly welcomed & thanked all the members of the Council for sparing their precious time for attending the meeting. The Vice-Chancellor in his opening remarks stated that a team work of honest and determined professionals has always played a pivotal role in the uplifting of any organization. We should promote liaison between the Teaching departments/administrative sections and leave no stone unturned in imparting quality education, production of market-oriented graduates, conducting of result-oriented research and fostering industry-academia linkages for finding our niche in the top ranking universities of the country. He expressed very categorically that everyone from top to rank is responsible to run the operation of the University in a professional fashion.

Thereafter the agenda of the meeting was taken up by the Registrar, Islamia College Peshawar Dr. Qasim Mansoor Jalali for deliberation in the following order:

ITEM # 1: CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 13TH MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL

DECISION:

The Academic Council confirmed the Minutes of 13th meeting of the Academic Council held on 12/11/2020.

ITEM # 2: CORRECTION/REVISION IN GRADING POLICY OF ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR BS REGULATIONS 2019

DECISION:

1. After thorough deliberation, the Academic Council referred the proposed amendments under Section 6.5 of the "Islamia College Peshawar Admission, Registration and Examination Regulations for BS and Equivalent Programs 2019" to the Academic Standing Committee for necessary corrections and re-submission of its recommendations to the Council for consideration.

Prof. Dr. Sareer Badshah, Department of Statistics recorded his vote of dissent on the adoption of absolute marking system.

2. The Academic Council nominated Dr. Sajjad Ahmad Khan, Department of Statistics, Islamia College Peshawar as member of the Academic Standing Committee in lieu of Prof. Dr. Muhammad Naeem Khalid, Department of Physics, Islamia College Peshawar.

ITEM # 3: REQUEST TO WAIVE INSTITUTIONAL CHARGES INCLUDING TUTION FEE, HOSTEL & UTILITY BILLS

DECISION:

The Council thoroughly deliberated on the subject matter in light of the findings of Provincial Ombudsman Secretariat Khyber Pakhtunkhwa made on the complaint of Mr. Saddat Hussain & Syed Ali Abbas, Department of English, Islamia College Peshawar received vide letter No: PO/Complaint/219/02/2020/339 Dated: 11/01/2021 and decided that owing to acute financial constraints, the University may not extend any other privileges beyond those which are already extended to this class of students vide Notification No. 2437/Acad Dated: 19.11.2018. The Council further decided that the Directorate of Students Affairs, Islamia College Peshawar may be requested to work out on the subject matter and facilitate them in obtaining need-based and other scholarships.

ITEM # 4: REQUEST FOR CONSIDERATION OF VARIOUS AMENDMENTS PROPOSED BY DIRECTOR, CENTRE FOR OMIC SCIENCES, ICP

DECISION:

The Council considered the following suggestions and decided as mentioned against each:

DECISION:

The Council referred the bill of amendments to Section-2 of the Islamia College Peshawar Higher Studies (M.Phil/MS/PhD) Regulations 2017 presented by the Controller of Examinations, Islamia College Peshawar in light of the Higher Education Commission Vide.No1-3/AD-QA/HEC/NQAC(21)/2016/53 dated: 18/03/2016 to the Academic Standing Committee for consideration and submission of its recommendations to the Council.

ITEM # 6: EXEMPTION OF CONTRACT EMPLOYEES SON FROM PAYMENT OF ADMISSION FEE

DECISION:

The Council unanimously regretted to grant exemption to the children/ward/spouse of any staff member working on Contract/Adhoc/Fixed pay/Contingent basis in whatever cadre VIZ; Teaching/administration/ancillary/support/technical from payment of any kind of fee.

ITEM # 8: REQUEST FOR RELAXATION OF 2-3 MONTHS WITHOUT FEE DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC

DECISION:

The Council unanimously interpreted the notification vide No. 3920/Acad Dated: 29.01.2021 in the following terms;

It is clarified for all concerned that owing to Covid-19 pandemic, the Higher Education Commission followed by the authorities of the University VIZ; Academic Council & Syndicate has extended one time relaxation for scholars of MS/M.Phil/equivalent programs who have achieved maximum duration of their study program for a period of one year (02 semesters) only. Whereas,

only those scholars who have achieved maximum duration of their study program and come under the above-referred category may be granted the waiver of one semester fee as notified vide notification No.3920/Acad dated 29.01.2021.

It was decided that no application of the student whatsoever would be entertained by any office, if the same is beyond the scope of the subject decision and subsequent clarification as referred above.

ITEM # 9: EXTRA WORK LOAD

DECISION:

After threadbare discussion, the following decisions were made:

- i. The faculty members having administrative assignments shall not be allowed to take extra workload of teaching beyond his routine duties.
- ii. The faculty members having no administrative assignments may be allowed to take extra workload of teaching beyond his routine duties.
- iii. As provided under Section-3.9.7 of the Islamia College Peshawar Admission, Registration and Examination Regulations for BS and Equivalent programs 2019, the Academic Council authorized the Vice-Chancellor, Islamia College Peshawar to determine the permissible limit of extra workload on case to case basis as per the requirement of each department in the University before the commencement of classes/semester. The Head of the Department concerned shall seek approval of the permissible limit of extra workload from the competent authority at least one week before the commencement of classes based on valid justification.

ITEM # 10: APPROVAL OF PROSPECTUS 2020 & ONWARD

DECISION:

The Council considered the proposed Prospectus for the Year 2020 & onward and acceded to.

ITEM # 11: VISION AND MISSION STATEMENT OF THE ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR

DECISION:

The Academic Council considered the recommendations of the Committee constituted vide No. 3252/Acad: Dated: 08/11/2019 and recommended the same to the Syndicate for consideration.

ITEM # 12: MINUTES OF THE 27TH MEETING OF THE ADVANCED STUDIES & RESEARCH BOARD (AS&RB), ISLAMIA COLLEGE PESHAWAR

DECISION:

The Academic Council considered and acceded to the minutes of 27th meeting of the Advanced Studies & Research Board (AS&RB), Islamia College Peshawar held on 6th April, 2021.

ITEM # 13: INITIATING TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL COURSES

DECISION:

The Council considered the concept paper for commencement of Technical and Vocational Courses in the University and recommended to the Syndicate for consideration/approval. Furthermore, the Registrar requested all the departments to share details of short courses that can be offered for accreditation through NAVTTC.

ADDITIONAL AGENDA (ON TABLE)

ITEM # 1: RE-VIVA OF BS (EDUCATION) STUDENT AS RECOMMENDED BY PROBE COMMITTEE

DECISION:

In order to thwart any administrative complications in future, therefore, Council considered the recommendations of the Probe Committee constituted vide Notification No. 1393/Estt: Dated: 07.10.2020 read with letter No. 406/Estt: Dated: 11.02.2021 but did not accede to.

However Prof. Dr. Muhammad Tariq Jan recorded his vote of dissent, whereas Dr. Arshad Ali, Chairman Department of Mathematics did not alter his stance recorded in the report of the Probe Committee.

ITEM # 2: REQUEST TO WAIVE-OFF FINE ON LATE PAYMENT OF SEMESTER FEE

DECISION:

Besides the educational institutions, the intra and inter-city transportation were closed on the instructions of the Government since March, 2021 owing to Covid-19 Pandemic and there was every likelihood of spreading of the virus. Therefore, the students did not



deposit their current semester fee well in time as was required. Hence, the Council decided to exempt the defaulter students of the current semester from the bar of penalty as provided under Section-9.25 of the "Regulations for Admission, Registration and Examinations regarding Semester Program of Islamia College Peshawar" as one-time relief. However, pecuniary penalty imposed on any defaulter student of the University in the light of the above-referred provision of the Regulations on account of non-depositing of fee of the previous semesters shall remain intact.

ITEM # 3: MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS HELD ON 28TH AND 30TH APRIL, 2021 IN THE DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY AND MAIN COMMITTEE ROOM RESPECTIVELY

DECISION:

Pursuant to the recommendations of the Committee notified vide No. 714/Estt: Dated: 01/04/2021, the Academic Council recommended to the Syndicate for consideration/approval of the following Policy for Refund of Hostel fee on account of cancellation of Hostel Admission:

The Academic Council considered the courses duly recommended by the Board of Faculty of Arts and Languages, ICP and acceded to the same with retrospective effect.





AMIR ULLAH KHAN CHAIRMAN DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE, ICP</u></p> <p><u>Reference to Letter No. 5174/Acad dated 07/07/2021 (Recording Observations on the Minutes of the 14th Meeting of the Academic Council held on 1st July 2021)</u></p> <p><u>Exemption of Contract Employees' Son from Payment of Admission Fee</u></p> <p>Decision of the Council: The Academic Council regretted this Item.</p> <p>The Case is mainly concerned with the illegal, unlawful, and unauthorized use of power by the then Registrar and then Legal Cell In-Charge in granting admission to Mr. Muhammad Aqib (BS English 2018-22) and Muhammad Haris (2nd Year) S/O Mr Javed Khan (Security Assistant on Contract, ICP). Following facts are placed before the Honorable Academic Council.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Mr. Javed Khan, Security Assistant on contract basis in ICP submitted his application to waive off fee for his son; and he himself highlighted and admitted that there was no quota for Contractual Employees' children. It clearly reflects that there was no such policy in this connection. ii. The then Registrar and then In-Charge Legal deliberately created doubts on such policy; and declared that the policy in this regard was not clear. iii. The then Registrar and then In-Charge Legal violated the merit of the University because the Marks of Mr Muhammad Aqib S/O Mr Javed Khan Roll No. 58121 was 846 while the Merit was 922; and granted conditional admission. This raised several legal questions which need to be addressed. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. On what legal jurisdiction/laws/rules/regulations such admission was granted? b. Was it not the gross violation of Admission Policy, Statutes, and other rules of the University? c. Who is (are) responsible for such violation? d. Why the Registrar Office concealed the real facts? 
