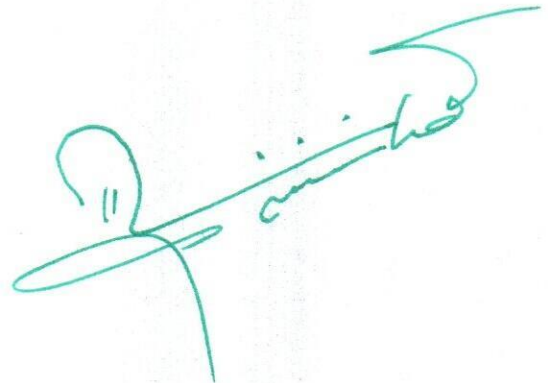

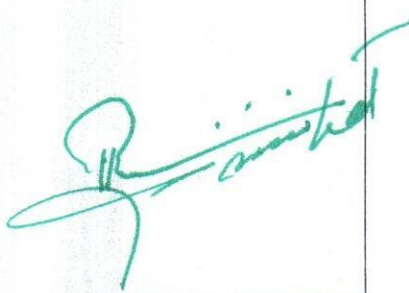
The proceedings of the meeting began with the recitation of few verses from the Holy Quran.

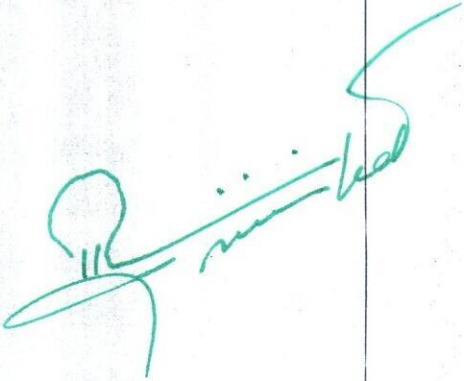

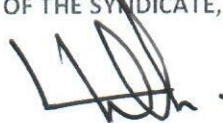

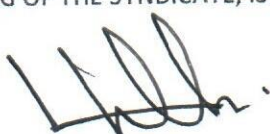

Similarly, as per Clause-vii of Sub-Section-1 of Section-5 of the Islamia College Peshawar Constitution, Functions and Powers of Authorities of the University Statutes, 2016, the Syndicate considered the nomination of Psychologist and appointed Prof. Dr. Muhammad Jehanzeb, University of Peshawar /Ex-Vice-Chancellor FATA University as Member of the Selection Board, Islamia College Peshawar.

The Syndicate further directed that in future a panel of at least three persons along with their CVs shall be placed before the Syndicate for nomination of the members under above mentioned sections of the Statute.
