Papers detailing fundamental breakthroughs in Physics, Chemistry, and Applied Mathematics and their immediate translation into engineering applications.

- **Format:** Electronic submission via email to the Focal Person.
- **Length:** Maximum 250 words, clearly summarizing objectives, methodology, results, and conclusion.
- **Keywords:** Include 3-5 relevant keywords.
- **Eligibility:** Minimum qualification for lead authors is B.Sc. / B.Sc. (Hons.) or equivalent. All submissions must align with conference themes.
