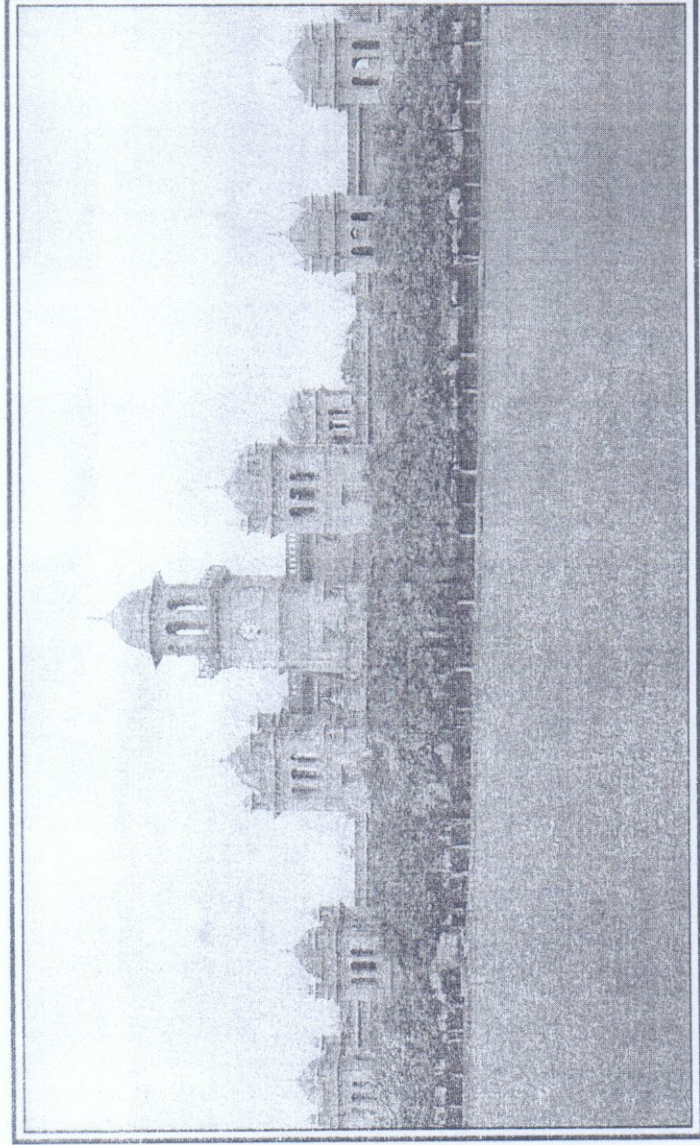


MINUTES OF THE 54th ASRB

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks to and by the Chair.


